Crimes:

All crimes listed below are automatically disqualifying if the applicant will or may be left alone with a vulnerable adult. If (5 or more years) or (3 or more years) follows the crime it means the person cannot be in a position to be left alone with a vulnerable adult unless/until 5 or more years or unless/until 3 or more years has passed since the date of the conviction (the final court date).

Negative Actions:

Negative action is an administrative action taken against an individual and may include:

- A decision issued after a due process hearing by an agency or an Administrative Law Judge showing a finding of abuse, neglect, exploitation, or abandonment of a vulnerable adult, juvenile or child;
- Termination, revocation, suspension, or denial of a license, certification, and/or State or Federal contract;
- Relinquishment of a license, certification, or contract in lieu of an agency negative action;
- Revocation, suspension, denial or restriction placed on a professional license; and
- Disciplinary Board Final Decisions.
