2.	Applicant has applied for Financial Aid for 2024-2025 at Edmonds College by filling out the FAFSA (https://studentaid.gov/) or WAFSA (https://wsac.wa.gov/wasfa).
3.	Applicant has completed all 7 prerequisite courses with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 and no less than a grade of 2.0 in any one class. To calculate your prerequisite courses cumulative GPA, simply add up the GPA from each course, then divide that number by 7.
